2018 Membership Referral Incentive Program

Guidelines for the Referral Incentive Program:

1. In order to qualify for a payment under the Membership Referral Incentive Program, you must be a member of **White Marsh Swim Club** in 2018.
2. The family or individual you are referring to **White Marsh Swim Club** in 2018 could not have been a member in 2017. Families or individuals that were not members in 2017, but were members prior to the 2017 season, may qualify as a new referral.
3. Only one referral payment will be made for each qualifying membership.
4. In order to qualify for the Membership Referral Incentive Program, the referring existing member's name must appear on the new member's application **at the time of submittal** to the **White Marsh Swim Club** for processing. Referring names cannot be added to the application after it is received by **White Marsh Swim Club** for processing.
5. There is no limit on the number of referrals an existing member may qualify for.
6. All referral incentive checks will be sent via mail on June 15. No credits can be applied to an existing membership.

1. Submit completed and signed membership application.
2. Submit completed and signed "Assumption of Risk and Indemnification Agreement." Every adult must sign, and all children must be listed and signed for by parent/legal guardian.
3. Submit membership fee or authorization to charge membership fee to credit card.
4. If you were a member last year and we have your picture(s) on file, you do not need to submit your picture(s) or membership card(s) with your application. If you are a new member or you have never submitted a picture, please submit a picture of everyone on the membership by one of the following methods:

or
Mail a colored picture (front-facing) of everyone on the membership. (Please attach and identify each picture on the roster provided.)

6. Pool passes will be mailed to you. All passes will be in one envelope bearing the primary member's name.



If paying by check, both checks need to be mailed in when registering. One check for 50% of member dues should be dated with the current date, the second check for the remaining 50% needs to be dated for June 1.

If paying by credit card, simply check the appropriate option in the "Method of Payment" on the application.

- Family membership plans may include only persons who are permanent members of your household. Documentation may be requested to confirm address.

- Exempt from membership fees are immediate family members **under 1 year of age** as of June 1st.
- All members must fully acknowledge and agree to the *Rules & Regulations*.
- There will be a \$25 fee for each returned check.

Season Guest Pass:

- This pass is an add-on to membership and cannot be purchased by a non-member. This pass can only be used by the member whose name appears on the guest pass.
- Pass can be used for guests, day care children, or babysitters.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT
NOTICE: THIS IS A RELEASE. READ CAREFULLY BEFORE SIGNING.

In consideration of the acceptance of my application for membership in **White Marsh Swim Club** (the "Swimming Facility"), and/or for the Swimming Facility's authorization of my entry onto and use of the facilities, including a swimming pool and associated equipment and facilities, at 4719 Beaconsfield Dr., White Marsh, Maryland 21236 (the "Pool"), I hereby freely and voluntarily agree to the following representations, waivers and agreements:

I know and understand that: (a) diving, swimming, accessing swimming areas, and/or making any other use of the Pool (collectively, "Activities") involves risk, including risk of personal injury and death; and (b) while engaging in Activities, I will be exposed to many natural, mechanical and environmental conditions and risks that independently or in any combination with my Activities or the Activities of others may cause injury including severe or fatal injuries to myself or others.

I agree that I alone am responsible for: (a) my proper preparation and safety while engaging in Activities; and (b) the preparation and safety of minors over whom I have control and/or supervision at the Swimming Facility. I have no physical or medical condition that would endanger me or others, while I am engaging in Activities. I am physically capable of participating in Activities and making the ordinary, regular, and intended use of the Pool. I am responsible for knowing and following all of the Swimming Facility's rules and procedures.

Being fully aware of the risks, conditions and hazards associated with my participation in Activities, **I HEREBY ACKNOWLEDGE**, that: (a) my participation in Activities is at my own risk; and (b) neither the Swimming Facility, nor any owner, operator, manager of, or service provider to the Swimming Facility, including but not limited to DRD Pool Management, Inc. and DRD Pool Service, Inc., or their respective officers, directors, founders, owners, employees, agents, or any other affiliated individuals and/or entities (the "Indemnified Parties"), are in any way responsible for my safety while at the Pool. **I FURTHER AGREE TO WAIVE, RELEASE, AND DISCHARGE**, for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators, legal representatives, assignees, and successors in interest (hereinafter "Successors"), any and all claims of damages for death or personal injury that I may have or that may hereafter accrue to me as a result of my participation in Activities, against any and all Indemnified Parties, to the fullest extent permitted by law, whether or not such injury was the result of negligence or carelessness on the part of any of the Indemnified Parties, and whether or not such injury was foreseeable, including all such claims regarding the design, maintenance, or condition of any structure, equipment, or device at the Pool, or of the pool, without regard to whether such equipment or device is specified or recommended by such Indemnified Parties, and without regard to whether such Indemnified Parties are properly charged with the maintenance of the Pool.

I further agree, for myself and my Successors, to forever **HOLD HARMLESS** and **INDEMNIFY** all Indemnified Parties, generally and specifically, from any and all liability for death or personal injury resulting in any way from my participation in Activities.

I also agree, for myself and my Successors, that the above representations are not mere recitals, are binding, and are intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Maryland. I further agree, for myself and my Successors, that should I or my Successors assert any claim in contravention of this agreement, I or my Successors shall be liable for the expenses (including attorneys' fees and costs) incurred by the other party or parties in defending against such claim, whether or not such injury was the result of negligence or carelessness on the part of the party or parties to be indemnified. I also agree that this agreement is for the benefit of all Indemnified Parties, all and any of which shall be entitled to enforce this agreement against me. If any term or provision of this agreement is found invalid or unenforceable, the remaining terms and provisions of this agreement shall remain binding and enforceable.

White Marsh Swim Club Rules & Regulations

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Membership Policy

1. Membership shall include only those persons who are permanent members of your household and who are listed on the Membership Application. Membership cards will be issued to each member designated on the Membership Application.
2. Every adult member must agree to and sign the assumption of risk and indemnification agreement. Parent/Legal Guardian must agree to and sign the assumption of risk and indemnification agreement for every child member.
3. Membership cards may be used only by the person named on the card. MEMBERSHIP CARDS ARE NOT TRANSFERABLE. Proof of identification may be required by the Pool Manager before admission to the Swim Club.
4. When entering the swim club, members must present their membership card to the gate attendant. **CARDS WILL NOT BE KEPT ON FILE.**
5. Management has the right to deny access to the swim club to any guest or member.
6. If a membership card is lost, stolen or destroyed, a duplicate card will be issued upon request.

Guest Policy

1. Each membership will be limited to 5 guests per day when entering with a member 16 years of age or older. If the member is under the age of 16, the member will be limited to 1 guest per day. Guest fees will be collected at the gate. In the event of pool closure, refund will be issued to guests who have been at the facility less than one hour.
2. If requested, guests must sign in upon entering the pool facility.
3. Guests must be accompanied by a member at all times. When the member leaves the pool, the guest must also leave.
4. The season guest pass can only be used by the member whose name appears on the guest pass.
5. Club members will be held responsible for all actions of their guests. The cost of any property damage by a guest or member will be charged to the member.
6. For groups larger than 5 guests, please call the administrative office at 410-785-7665 to make arrangements. Groups larger than 5 guests will not be admitted in the pool/pool area without prior approval from the administrative office.

Health Regulations

1. All persons must shower before entering the pool.
2. Expectorating, nose blowing, spouting of water, eliminating of body wastes and unhygienic acts into the pool are prohibited.
3. Admission shall be refused to all persons having infectious disease, sore or inflamed eyes, colds, nasal or ear discharges, excessive sunburn, open sores or bandages of any kind.
4. No pets are allowed in the pool area at any time.
5. In the event of vomit, blood and/or fecal contamination, pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations.

Responsibilities

1. All persons included on the membership and their guests agree to abide by the regulations listed and any additional rules posted and administered by the Manager/Staff. They further agree to accept the penalties for infraction of those rules and regulations.
2. If a member elects to drop their membership, there will be no refund.
3. Parent/Guardian agrees to allow the Manager/Staff to assign and enforce appropriate punishment for their child's rule infraction.
4. Members and their guests agree to be responsible for the cost of all medical expenses incurred for injuries sustained while using the facilities of the Swim Club and members assume the sole responsibility of any first aid treatment sought and received from the Swim Club including, but not limited to, allergic reaction to first aid remedies rendered. We request that you bring your medicine or allergic reaction kits with you to the Swim Club for bee stings, etc.
5. Members agree to be personally responsible for all personal items.
6. As a member or a guest of the Swim Club, you grant permission to use photographs, images and/or videos taken for use in materials that include, but may not be limited to, printed brochures, newsletter, videos and digital images for the website and social media pages.

Penalties

1. The Swim Club reserves the right to rescind membership for major or continued rule infraction at any time with no refund.
2. Penalties for unsafe conduct (to self and others), destruction of property, littering, unpaid or unregistered guests and resisting authority will be in accordance with severity and repetitiveness of the acts.
3. Misrepresentation of family members or misuse of membership cards will result in termination of Swim Club membership without refund.
4. There will be a \$25.00 fee charged for any returned checks.

White Marsh Swim Club Rules & Regulations

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General Policy

1. The lifeguard must be on duty and the pool officially open before any user is allowed in the water.
2. All persons using the pool or pool area do so at their own risk and sole responsibility. Management does not assume responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use.
3. The patrons agree to save harmless the White Marsh Swim Club, L.L.C., its Officers, Board of Directors, Management of White Marsh Swim Club, and the employees of White Marsh Swim Club from any and all liabilities and/or action of any patron resulting from the use of the swimming pool or pool area.
4. The cost of any property damage will be charged to the responsible party.
5. Management will not be responsible for loss of or damage to any personal property of any kind. Lost and found items will be discarded biweekly.
6. The pool may be closed at any time due to mechanical breakdown, operational difficulties, inclement weather, special Club events or other appropriate circumstances. No dues or part thereof shall be refunded in the event that pool operations are required to be suspended for any period. The decision is at the sole discretion of Management.
7. Wearing proper bathing attire is required. Street shoes, sneakers, "flip-flops," cut-offs, walking shorts or indiscreet attire is not permitted in the pool.
8. All radios must be kept at a low volume.
9. No abusive/profane language or breach of the peace will be tolerated. There will be a zero tolerance policy regarding profane language, the use of which will result in immediate ejection from the pool by Management.
10. Baby strollers and wheel chairs are not permitted within five feet of the main pool.
11. All beverages or food brought into the pool area must be in paper or plastic containers and be consumed in designated areas. No glass of any kind is permitted. All trash must be disposed of in a trash container.
12. Other than special events, no alcoholic beverages may be brought into the pool area during normal hours of operation.
13. Chewing gum is not permitted in the pool area at any time.
14. Reserving chairs, lounges, tables, etc. is not permitted.
15. Cellular phone, phone camera, camera, and video camera use is strictly prohibited in all public locker, shower and changing areas. Anyone found to be in violation of this policy will be prosecuted to the full extent of the law and banned from the facility. This policy may require the staff to question any patron at the facility that they have reason to believe is in possession of one of these items. This is for each member's protection as cellular phone technology allows individuals to take photographs without consent.
16. All persons use this facility at their own risk and in accordance with all rules and regulations. Individuals may be barred from the pool or pool area at the discretion of the Manager for violation of said rules or for any other reason which in his/her judgment constitutes inappropriate conduct or a hazard to others or to the Management.
17. Management reserves the right to change the rules and regulations without prior notice to members.
18. Adult Swim will be called for 15 minutes **every hour** on the hour starting at noon daily. During the 1pm, 3pm, and 5pm adult swim, all patrons under 18 years of age must vacate the shallow area of the pool. During the 1pm, 3pm, and 5pm adult swim, no one under 18 years of age is permitted to enter the toddler pool area unless accompanied by an adult. This is intended to prevent a mass influx of patrons into the toddler area during the adult swim.
19. White Marsh Swim Club is a smoke-free facility. Smoking is prohibited.

General Safety Regulations

1. No glass of any kind is permitted on the Swim Club grounds.
2. Glass masks are not permitted on the Swim Club grounds or in the pool.
3. Small/camper style portable propane grills will be permitted, but must be placed adjacent to the perimeter pool fence. Propane grills must be removed daily and area cleaned.
4. In the main pool (including shallow kiddie area) inner tubes, water wings and all other flotation devices are not permitted at any time. For safety purposes, only a life vest approved by the United States Coast Guard is to be used. If a child uses such a life vest, a parent or guardian must accompany the child in the water at all times.
5. Noodles will be allowed if utilized in a safe manner and at Management's discretion. High power water guns are not permitted.
6. Running, pushing, wrestling or causing undue disturbance will not be permitted on the Swim Club grounds or in the pool.
7. All personal injuries, however slight, must be reported to the Manager.
8. Lap lane is for lap swimming only.
9. Front flips are permitted off the diving board, but back dives and back flips are strictly prohibited.
10. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time. Patron using the diving board must wait on the deck until the person in the water reaches the ladder. Only one bounce is permitted. Children are NOT allowed to jump to their parent/guardian off the diving board. No flotation devices are allowed while jumping from the board. No diving or jumping toward walls will be permitted.
11. General swimming is permitted in the diving area only when diving board is closed and only at manager's discretion.
12. Management reserves the right to close the shallow kiddie area of the main pool during adult swim if it becomes too crowded.

White Marsh Swim Club Rules & Regulations

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Children

1. Parent/Guardian must closely watch children at all times. Parent/Guardian must accompany a non-swimmer in the water within arm's reach at all times.
2. Parent/Guardian is solely responsible for assessing and knowing their child's swimming ability. Parent/Guardian is solely responsible for approaching the manager if they feel the child's swimming ability needs to be assessed.
3. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by and supervised by a member or designated guest 16 years of age or older who is to be present at all times.
4. Infants and children wearing diapers or who are not toilet trained shall be permitted in the main pool, but must wear swim diapers **AND** tight fitting rubber/waterproof pants (can be purchased at: clothdiaper.com). In the event of fecal contamination, pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations.
5. Parent/Guardian will be responsible for the safety of their children when they are using the pool facilities.
6. Parent/Guardian of children must remove all toys and debris of any type upon request of the pool manager.
7. Parent/Guardian must accompany children 7 years of age and under and non-swimmers to the bathroom at all times.
8. Children 8 years of age and over must use gender appropriate bathroom.

Toddler Pool (with Mushroom)

1. This pool is intended for the use and enjoyment of younger children and their parents/guardians. Running, pushing, wrestling, or causing undue disturbance will not be tolerated. Older children who act inappropriately or jeopardize the safety of infants and toddlers will be **permanently** ejected from this area. No exceptions. At the manager's discretion, children who vacate the main pool during adult swim may not be permitted in the Toddler Pool during adult swim.
2. Infants and children wearing diapers or who are not toilet trained shall be permitted in the toddler pool, but must wear swim diapers **AND** tight fitting rubber/waterproof pants (can be purchased at: clothdiaper.com). In the event of fecal contamination, pool will be closed in accordance with Health Department regulations.
3. Children under 10 years of age must be accompanied by and supervised by a member or designated guest 16 years of age or older who is to be present at all times.
4. Parent/Guardian must accompany a non-swimmer in the water at all times.
5. Play toys and artificial flotation devices will be permitted in this pool only with adult supervision and at the discrepancy of Management.
6. Children 10 years of age and older are not permitted to use the toddler pool.

Water Slide

1. Patrons under 12 years of age must pass the deep water assessment in order to ride the slide.
2. Maximum rider weight is 250 pounds.
3. Rider must obey all instructions given by the lifeguard, dispatcher, and splash pool supervisor who have the authority to prevent any conditions which leads to unsafe operation of the water slide.
4. Sliders must exit the drop zone promptly.
5. Sliders must be clear of the drop zone before next rider may enter the slide.
6. Only one rider at a time. Absolutely no groupings or forming chains of riders.
7. Rider must ride slide feet first while lying down on their backs with arms crossed on their stomach.
8. Rider must keep all parts of the body within the slide flume.
9. No diving, running, standing, kneeling, rotating, tumbling, or stopping in flume.
10. No balls, tubes, mats, noodles, or life vests are permitted on the slide.
11. Do not use the slide when under the influence of alcohol or impairing drugs.
12. Riders must wear bathing suits when using the slide.
